We named it the DeCube mattress and this design would soon equip thousands of beds, help prevent and treat countless wounds and save hospitals millions that were previously being spent for wound prevention and treatment.

When the internationally recognized **Lancet Journal of Medicine** published a report about the DeCube's effectiveness, Comfortex moved from that cute little company with a cute little mattress, into an innovative leader the more established companies would either copy... or criticize.
